- Managing complex and high-risk cases, including clients with multiple comorbidities, dementia, or palliative care needs.
- Applying clinical reasoning to assess situations holistically and determine the best course of action – particularly in ambiguous or rapidly changing situations.
- Providing clinical guidance to Care Partners and support workers, and escalating concerns appropriately.
- Coordinating with GPs, allied health, hospitals, and external providers to support safe transitions of care.
- Maintaining accurate clinical documentation and contributing to clinical governance and continuous improvement.
